GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR THE INFORMATION OF APPLICANTS

1. AGE LIMIT as on 20.01.2012

For Post Code I to VII : Between 18 to 30 Years

For Post Code VIII to X: Between 18 to 25 Years

2. AGE RELAXATION:

a) ST : 5 years.

b) OBC : 3 years

Note: The above age relaxation is applicable only in respect of posts reserved for respective categories.

SC/ST/OBC certificates in the prescribed proforma applicable to Central Government Employment. OBC for the purpose of age relaxation and reservation will mean "Persons of OBC Categories not belonging to the "Creamy Layer" as defined in the Government of India, Department of Personal and Training OM NO. 36012/22/93-Estt. (SCT) dated 08.09.1993 and modified vide Government of India Department of Personnel and Training OM No. 36033/3/2004-Estt. (Res.) dated 09.03.2004 and OM No. 36033/3/2004-Estt. (Res.) dated 14.10.2008.

c) Physically Handicapped Persons

: Upto a maximum of 5 (five) years for candidates with disabilities (hearing impaired- Partially deaf) and Orthopedically handicapped (One Leg or One arm affected) applying for post code VII (Upto a maximum of ten years for SC/ST candidates and eight years for OBC candidates).

Note: According to the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Rules, 1996 notified on 31.12.1996 by the Central Govt. in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub Section (1 and 2) of Section 73 of the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995 (1 of 1996), a disability certificate shall be issued by a Medical Board duly constituted by the Central or a State Government.

- d) Relaxation of the upper age limit of five years shall be admissible to children/family members of those who died in the 1984 riots. Proof to the effect that they have been affected by 1984 riots should be furnished.
- e) **Ex-servicemen**: After deducting the period of armed force service from the actual age of the candidate the resultant age should not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years.
- f) Govt. Servants: In accordance with orders of the Central Govt.
- 3. Relaxation in the upper age limit of 5 years shall be admissible to all persons who had ordinarily been domiciled in Kashmir division of the state of Jammu & Kashmir during the period from 1st day of January 1980 to 31st day of December, 1989 provided that the relaxation in the upper age limit for appearing at any examination shall be subject to the maximum number of chances permissible under the relevant rules.

Certificate regarding proof of residence -

Any person intending to avail of this relaxation of age limit admissible under rule 3 shall submit a certificate from:

 a) the District Magistrate in the Kashmir division within whose jurisdiction he had ordinarily resided;

or

(b) any other authority designated in this behalf by the government of Jammu & Kashmir to the effect that he had ordinarily been domiciled in the Kashmir division of the state of Jammu & Kashmir during the period from the 1st day of January, 1980 to the 31st day of December, 1989

- 4. Interview will be held at RRCAT Indore. To & fro Sleeper Class rail fare by shortest route will be reimbursed to the candidates called for interview from out-stations for the post code I & II on production of rail/bus tickets. Only SC/ST candidates called for interview from out-stations for the post code III to X are eligible for reimbursement of to & fro Sleeper Class rail fare by shortest route on production of rail/bus tickets provided they are not working under any Central/State Govt./Public Sector Undertakings/Corporations/Local govt./Panchayats etc.
