## PROMOTION RULES

### For classes III to VIII

1. The system of general promotion will be followed.
2. Academic prizes are to be given only to those students securing A1 in all subjects both in Term-1 as well as Term-2.
3. A student not appearing in the Term-2/yearly examination due to valid medical reason (Certificate to be furnished by DAE doctors/Hospital) may be granted weightage on the basis of his /her performance in Term-1/Half Yearly examination. However he/she is not eligible for Academic prize.

### For classes IX and X : The weightage of marks for assessment

- 1) In class IX student failing in two or less subjects in annual examination and internal assessment will be eligible for appearing in compartment examination. Failure in more than two subjects shall detain the student in class IX itself.
- 2) For class X promotion rules are as per CBSE guidelines.
- 3) A student not appearing in the Annual examination due to valid medical reason (Certificate to be furnished by DAE doctors/Hospital) may be granted weightage on the basis of his /her performance in 3 periodic tests. However he/she is not eligible for Academic prize.
- 4) Academic prizes are to be given only to those students who secure A1 in all subjects in the final grade.

**For class XI: The weightage of marks in Unit tests, Half Yearly & Annual Examinations.**

1. A student must secure 33% in the final weightage in each subject to pass the class XI.
2. In practical subjects, students must pass separately in theory & practical.
3. The student failing in one subject may appear in compartment examination to be held in April 2020 and the student failing in more than one subject will be detained.

**For class XII:** As per C.B.S.E. norms.

Note: It is mandatory for the students to appear in all the tests/Examinations.

### **GENERAL RULES**

1. Any student found to have used unfair means during or after the examination will be awarded zero in the answer book.
2. Absence without notice and without valid reason in any examination or part thereof excludes a student from being promoted to the next higher class.
3. Minimum of 75% attendance is essential for appearing in the Board's Annual Examination. Leave is not counted as 'Presence'. Students having less than 75% attendance in any class will not be allowed to appear in the Annual Examination except on Medical Grounds.
4. After Term Examinations, the progress report of the students will be sent to the parent/guardian for perusal, signature and will be taken back.
5. For classes I to V, question cum answer-books will be provided for all the examinations.
6. Students of class VI onwards will have printed question papers and separate answer-books.
7. No re-test will be conducted for absentees.
