Common reasons for rejection of Bids

- Many of the offers received from the vendors against tenders released by IRPU/DPS on GeM as well as on CPP portals gets rejected due to non fulfilling NIT conditions.
- Main reasons are given for information and benefit of vendors/bidders to avoid bid rejection.

Non Submission of required documents

- Non submission of the correct documents or submission of the unsigned documents or not in the prescribed format, wherever required as per the tenders / bid
 - <u>"Annexure XI"</u>: regarding declaration of local content as per the MII policy,

• <u>must be submitted for all tenders with cost > 5 Lacs</u>

• "Annexure XII" regarding (bidders from a country which shares land border with India)

• <u>must be submitted even if local content declared upto 100%</u>

These formats are attached with the bids itself !!

Submission of incorrect documents

- It is observed that some of the vendors are uploading the Annexure – XI, XII & DPS – 102A with digital signature of date prior to release of tender in CPP portal (*i.e. formats / declarations submitted against old tenders*) which cannot be considered.
- Signature on the declaration needs to be the date after release of the tender and before due date.

NON-RECEIPT OF ORIGINAL DD / BG TOWARDS EMD

Scanned copy of the Demand Draft / Bank Guarantee towards EMD is to be uploaded by bidder in the online bid on <u>GeM Portal</u> and hard copy of the same will have to be submitted directly to the Buyer <u>within 5 days of bid</u> <u>opening</u>, failing which the bid may be treated as incomplete & may lead to rejection of the bid by buyer without making any reference to the seller.

Demand draft towards EMD for the bids released <u>in</u> <u>CPP portal</u> is to be received within the opening date of tenders. However the same are not received because of which offers are getting rejected due to non submission of EMD by the vendors.

FALSE / INVALID CLAIM FOR EMD EXEMPTION

- Whenever vendors are claiming exemption from EMD or declaring themselves as MSE vendors for claiming benefits under the MSE, they should upload a <u>valid</u> <u>MSE certificate</u> for that category (e.g Manufacturer for primary category of offered item) at appropriate place mentioned in the CPP portals for getting the exemption benefit.
- Indian bidder's submitting quote on behalf of Foreign supplier also MUST submit EMD, even if the quote is in INR.
