Project work opportunities for Management Students pursuing Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) / Bachelor of Business Management (BBM) / Master of Business Administration (MBA) from Indian Institutions towards partial fulfilment of their degree program

Raja Ramanna Centre for Advanced Technology, Indore is a premier Centre of the Department of Atomic Energy, Government of India, engaged in R & D activities in front line research areas of Accelerator science, Laser science, related technologies and applications. These areas of R & D encompass work in all disciplines of science and engineering and their applications.

The technology intensive R & D projects being pursued at RRCAT, Indore have project work opportunities for bright and motivated students pursuing Management degrees from Indian institutions of higher learning. The selected students will get the opportunity to contribute to the Project Management of these high-tech R & D projects.

The project work / internship opportunities will be offered in the following domains of management depending upon the educational background, specific interest, and the duration of project work / internship:

Project Management; Operations Management; User Centric Project Structure; Progress Monitoring; Human Centred Leadership; Relationship Management; Risk Based Thinking; Project Risk Analysis and Management; Templates for Required Specifications; Quality Testing Standardisation; Project Organisation Culture; Project Organisation Behaviour; and many such interrelated areas.

Number of project internships: 10 per year

<u>Duration of internship:</u> The internship duration may vary between six months and twelve months depending on the student's and college's academic engagements. The internship will be done partly at RRCAT campus and partly at intern's college under the guidance of RRCAT's project guide. The project intern is expected to spend two months at RRCAT campus which may also be accounted as "corporate internship" to meet the academic requirements of the degree program.

<u>Guides for the project work:</u> The Selected student has to carry out the project work under the guidance of a Scientist or an Engineer of RRCAT.

Application Procedure:

Interested students should send his/ her application in the prescribed format duly forwarded by their Head of the Institution. Incomplete applications or not forwarded through Head of the Institute will be rejected.

Students will be selected based on their academic profile and the availability of suitable Guide in the area of interest (if any) mentioned in the application form. Selected candidates will be informed about their selection through email given in the application form.

Duration of Project Internship and Important Dates

The applications will be accepted round the year. The internship duration and start date will be decided based on requirements and consents of student, college and RRCAT's project guide.

Hostel Accommodation to Students

Hostel accommodation may be provided to the outstation students, subject to availability in any of the hostels at RRCAT. Students have to strictly follow the discipline and guidelines as specified by the concerned authorities of RRCAT.

Financial Assistance

Students who complete project work of 6 months or more are eligible for financial assistance, which includes: (i) monthly stipend of Rs. 1000/- for the duration of project work, (ii) reimbursement of "to and fro" second class railway fare, from the place of study to Indore or ordinary bus fare. Financial Assistance is provided to only those students who are NOT getting any stipend, scholarship etc. from any other source. This must be certified by the Head of Department/ Institution.
