

N.15: Fire safety in RRCAT

Several measures were in place to ensure fire safety at RRCAT. A Fire Station having multipurpose fire tender was kept operational round-the-clock to mitigate any fire incident. First Aid Fire Fighting (FAFF) Training was imparted to every employee, contract workers and trainees so that they are prepared to help in extinguishing any fire incident. Total 153 persons were imparted training during Jan-June 2019. Fire extinguishers are installed in all the buildings inside the technical area and also in the multistoried buildings in the colony. These were checked. In addition, fire and smoke detector and alarm systems deployed in a number of buildings, were checked

Mock drills were carried out periodically to keep the personnel abreast of the procedures to be followed in any fire incident. During Feb 23-24, 2019 National Science Day (NSD) was celebrated, and live demonstrations were arranged for students of various schools and colleges. Like every year, National Fire Service Week (NFSW) was observed in RRCAT during Apr 14-20, 2019, to promote fire safety awareness among employees, their family members and Atomic Energy Central School (AECS) students. Various fire safety related activities were organized during this week.
