

### N.12: Vigilance Awareness Week-2019 celebrated at RRCAT

In accordance with the directives received from Central Vigilance Commission (CVC), the Vigilance Awareness Week-2019 was observed at RRCAT during 28<sup>th</sup> October 2019 to 2<sup>nd</sup> November 2019 with the theme “Integrity – A way of life (ईमानदारी-एक जीवन शैली)”. The following activities were conducted during the above period:

Banners on anti-corruption drive were displayed in the campus indicating the observance of Vigilance Awareness Week-2019. A pledge was taken by the staff members followed by collective singing of National Anthem on 28<sup>th</sup> October 2019 at 11.00 Hrs. The pledge was administered by the Heads of the Division in their respective Divisions. A poster making competition on Vigilance was organized in which 12 employees of RRCAT participated. An essay competition was conducted on 29<sup>th</sup> October 2019, both in Hindi and English, on the topic “Integrity – A way of life (ईमानदारी-एक जीवन शैली)” in which 17 employees of RRCAT and one employee of CISF unit, RRCAT participated. A quiz was conducted on 1<sup>st</sup> November 2019 in which about 80 employees of RRCAT participated.
